

Regulations

1. The administrator of personal data is Unitravel Kieljan Lis Spółka Jawna, with its registered office in Łódź, at ul. Łączna 38/40/89, 93-166 Łódź, hereinafter referred to as Unitravel.
2. With regard to personal data, Unitravel operates based on applicable data protection regulations, in particular on the basis of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR).
3. Data is collected and processed as follows:
 - a) collected for specific, explicit, and legally justified purposes while minimizing the amount of personal data to the necessary content,
 - b) processed in a manner ensuring appropriate security of personal data,
 - c) protected using technical, physical, or organizational measures against unauthorized, unlawful processing, accidental loss, destruction, distortion, or damage,
 - d) processed lawfully in a transparent, clear, and understandable manner for the data subject,
 - e) not processed in a manner incompatible with the purpose for which it was collected,
 - f) limited to what is necessary for the realization of the purposes for which they are processed,
 - g) accurate and, if necessary, updated or restricted,
 - h) stored for no longer than necessary for the purposes for which the data is processed,
 - i) stored in a form that allows the identification of the data subject.
4. If the processing of personal data is based on consent, every data subject has the right to withdraw it at any time.
5. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of data processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal. The consent is independent of the duration of the services used and remains valid until revoked.
6. Providing personal data is voluntary but necessary to participate in the procurement process organized by Unitravel. Refusal to provide personal data may result in the inability to provide services that require the submission of such data.
7. Personal data provided to Unitravel is not shared with other businesses or organizations, except in cases and to the extent necessary for properly making reservations, issuing airline tickets, or other documents related to travel arrangements.
8. Personal data is transferred to the IT systems of providers to issue documents authorizing the use of their services (e.g., insurance). The traveler consents to such processing and transmission of personal data.
9. Data may be transferred to the following entities:
 - a) processors in connection with the execution of services purchased by travelers,
 - b) cooperating entities and contractors,
 - c) law firms that may conduct proceedings for Unitravel,
 - d) entities or authorities authorized under the law,
 - e) entities responsible for managing a given product or online service,
 - f) third parties for payment processing.

11. Personal data is processed for the following purposes:
 - a) conclusion and execution of the contract (service provision),
 - b) undertaking actions at the request of the data subject before concluding a contract under Article 6(1)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679,
 - c) mediation for concluding or executing a contract (service provision),
 - d) archiving,
 - e) conducting analyses and statistics,
 - f) carrying out marketing activities independently or in cooperation with other entities,
 - g) responding to letters and requests,
 - h) if no contract is concluded and no service is provided in accordance with the Regulations, the data will be archived and not used for purposes other than asserting, defending, or determining mutual claims.
12. The period of processing personal data depends on the purpose for which the data is processed and will be determined based on the following criteria:
 - a) legal regulations that may impose data processing or archiving for a specified period,
 - b) the period during which services are provided,
 - c) the period until the expiration or limitation of claims,
 - d) the period necessary to protect the Administrator's interests,
 - e) the duration of the granted consent.
13. Additionally, we inform you that you have the following rights:
 - a) the right to access data,
 - b) the right to be informed,
 - c) the right to rectify data,
 - d) the right to restrict processing,
 - e) the right to erasure ("right to be forgotten"),
 - f) the right to data portability,
 - g) the right to object.
14. In case of doubts regarding the correctness of the processing of personal data, you have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory authority.
15. A user who has consented to receiving information about current promotions, travel destination tips, and information about Unitravel, providers, and other business partners via email has the right to unsubscribe from receiving such commercial information at any time.
16. Personal data may be transferred outside the EU to entities participating in the provision of the selected service only for the purpose of executing that service, ensuring appropriate safeguards.
